

Catching Up on Assignments Online

There are numerous online resources available to the Great Neck Middle School teaching staff for posting course materials and assignments (e.g., class work, homework, worksheets, handouts, etc.). Each teaching staff member has shared with his/her students how to access his/her “virtual classroom” and which resources have been incorporated to augment in-school instruction via the school division’s Intranet and the Internet. Students have been asked to add teachers’ virtual classroom access information in their agendas and/or their notebooks. The links below offer quick access to the virtual classroom resources.

[MySchool Mail](#) – Parents and caregivers can subscribe to school and team messages which usually are sent out each school day.

[Teacher Websites](#) – Teacher Websites provide links to course information and assignments. Many teaching staff members link to their respective SharePoint Student Portal sites to provide deeper resources. This electronic presence of resources is referred to by the GNMS staff as a *virtual classroom*. A [directory](#) is provided for easy access to specific virtual classrooms.

[SharePoint Student Portal \(login\)](#) – Teacher class sites and a personal area (portal) for data storage is accessible to students at school and at home. Students must know his/her school network user name and password to obtain access. Teachers have the option of utilizing SharePoint Student Portal as a part of their virtual classrooms.

[SharePoint Student Portal](#) – The division’s page provides helpful information about the resource and how to access it.
